## Farrar Running for County Property Appraiser

Titusville – Penny Farrar on Tuesday announced her candidacy for Brevard County Property Appraiser.

Farrar is the first candidate to file with the Supervisor of Elections Office for the office of Property Appraiser for the 2004 election.

In 2000, Farrar who had never run for public office before ran for county property appraiser and captured 34 percent of the vote against a long time incumbent. You may remember her campaign slogan, "Vote for Penny, It just makes CENTS". You may also remember that just three days before the 2000 election, an employee of the incumbent, who was also working on his campaign, filed a lawsuit against Farrar. A judge had dismissed the suit, then the compliant was amended. The compliant has been filed and amended a total of four times.

"I believe they have kept this lawsuit alive to encourage me not to run this time but that won't happen", Farrar said. "Its time that the citizens of Brevard County had a new Property Appraiser. One that will accept responsibility for the part the Property Appraiser plays in determining the amount of property taxes we pay."

Farrar promises to work for fair, equitable and correct property assessments, believes in fiscal accountability and pledges to eliminate wasteful spending.

"I believe in term limits of no more than two terms. Ford has been hunkered down in that office for 16 years far beyond two terms."

The countywide election for property appraiser will be held on August 31, if a primary is needed, and on November 2, 2004 for the general election.
